Exhibit 10.1 - UAA Licensing Agreement (Summary)

This document summarizes the main aspects of the UAA Licensing Agreement. Only the UAA Licensing Agreement constitutes the legal agreement.

(This Summary is not a legal agreement)

- 1. <u>License Grant</u>. Subject to the terms of this Agreement (including without limitation, any termination thereof), Licensor hereby grants (the "License Grant") to Client a royalty-free, perpetual, fully paid up, non-exclusive (other than as set forth below), non-transferable, non-sublicenseable license to use the registered trademarks of Licensor set forth on Schedule 1
- 2. Client shall use its best efforts to establish and operate a <u>Uniquely Abled Academy</u> according to the guidelines in the Uniquely Abled Academy Replication Guide and encourage the job developers involved with the UAA to view the Job Developer Workshop videos.
- 3. Client agrees that that in respect of each Uniquely Abled Academy cohort, Client shall furnish to the Licensor <u>high level statistics</u> in respect of the operation of the Uniquely Abled Academy, specifically, the number of students enrolled, the number of students graduated, the number of graduates employed, and the job retention rate of the graduates, in such manner and at such times as reasonably requested by Licensor; and
- 4. <u>License Fee; Expenses</u>. In exchange for the License Grant, Client shall pay to Licensor a one-time fee of \$10.000.
- 5. <u>Services</u>. For no additional consideration, Licensor shall provide to Client, the services, information, and documents set forth on <u>Exhibit A</u> hereto (the "**Services**").
