ABOUT THE PROGRAM

A Uniquely Abled Academy (UAA) is a 13-16 week career training program for individuals with an autism diagnosis (mild support needs).

Students receive training and instruction in preparation for successful careers in the manufacturing industry as Computer Numerical Control (CNC) machinists.

Students will receive:

- 300 hours of in-class instruction and 60 hours of jobreadiness instruction.
- Soft skills coaching, an updated resume, and schedule job interviews.
- Certificates/Credentials
- Training to program and operate CNC machines, shop mathematics, how to read blue-prints, and more.

Our program is 100% free to accepted applicants!

Participant Requirements:

- Must be 18+ with a High School or GED diploma.
- Ability to demonstrate basic Algebra and English skills.
- Available to participate M F, up to 8 hours a day.
- Comfortable with working with machinery in an industrial environment.
- A good attitude, with the ability to work independently in social and academic settings.
